The show, which will feature the work of Léa Peterson (www.leapetersonart.net) and Susan Zimmerman, will be on display at the Grill August 9 through September 20.

"These two talented artists, who often paint en plein air, bring Maine's coastal and outdoor wonders alive," said Kerrigan. "Their use of bold colors is especially festive, and our guests are certain to enjoy their talent for capturing our truly unique surroundings here in Maine."

Peterson is an award-winning artist who lives in Georgetown, Maine. She focuses her work, in both oil and pastels, on seascapes and landscapes, capturing Maine's rocky coast, surf, shore, meadows and inlets, as well as the people who enjoy and work in those spaces.

Her paintings are held in many private collections in several countries and have appeared in juried exhibitions at the Time Gallery, Saco Museum, Chocolate Church, Blue Marble Gallery, Harlow Gallery, and Maine Art Gallery. Her primary venues are the Old Post Office Gallery in Georgetown and the Sebascodegan Gallery on Orr's Island.

Susan Zimmerman moved to Maine from Philadelphia and quickly learned to embrace the outdoors. It is there that she takes note of people enjoying Maine—sailing, hiking, eating at sidewalk cafes, and picking wild blueberries—and incorporates the images into her art.
